

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Contributors are requested to strictly adhere to the following submission guidelines to ensure smooth peer review and publication processes. Any submission not complying with these guidelines will be returned for revision, which may cause delays or disqualification.

I. Abstract Submission

- Word Limit: 250–300 words
- Content: Abstract must clearly outline the background, objectives, core arguments, and scope of the proposed chapter.
- Acceptance Requirement: Only upon acceptance of the abstract, authors will be invited to submit the full chapter.
- Abstract Notification: Authors will be notified of acceptance status on the date specified in the timeline section of this brochure.

II. Chapter Submission

- Word Limit: 4000–8000 words (excluding footnotes/references)
- Title Page Must Include:
 - Title of the Chapter
 - Author(s) Full Name(s)
 - Designation and Institutional Affiliation
 - Email ID and Contact Number
- Co-authorship: Permitted up to a maximum of two authors per chapter
- File Format: Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx)
 only

III. Formatting Guidelines

- Font: Times New Roman
- Title: 16 pt, Bold, Centered
- Headings: 14 pt, Bold
- Body Text: 12 pt, Regular
- Line Spacing: 1.5
- Alignment: Justified on all sides
- Margins: 1 inch on all sides
- Footnotes: Font Size 10 pt, Single-spaced
- Page Numbering: Bottom-right corner

IV. Citation & Referencing Style

- Mandatory Citation Style: Bluebook 21st Edition
- All citations must be in the form of footnotes only.
 Endnotes or inline citations will not be accepted.
- Consistency in citation style is expected throughout the chapter.

V. Plagiarism & Al Usage Policy

- Submissions must be original and unpublished.
- Plagiarism must not exceed 10%, as per the guidelines of the University Grants Commission (UGC), India.
- All manuscripts will undergo plagiarism checks using standard software.
- Use of Generative Al tools to write the chapter is strictly prohibited.
- The author(s) shall be solely responsible for any plagiarism or ethical violations found during or after publication.

- The abstract must adhere to the specified guidelines and must be submitted only via the form.
 Submissions via email or any other mode will not be considered.
- Only upon selection of the abstract, the author(s) will be notified through email regarding:
 - Acceptance of their abstract
 - Chapter formatting guidelines
 - Instructions for final chapter submission
 - Details regarding a nominal publication fee to support editorial, ISBN, and design-related expenses
- Submissions of full chapters will be accepted only from selected authors, as per the timeline mentioned in this brochure.
- All communication post-acceptance will be sent to the email ID provided in the registration form.
 Contributors are requested to check their inbox/spam folders regularly during the review period.

REVIEW & EDITORIAL PROCESS

- All chapters will undergo a double-blind peer review to assess originality, relevance, and academic rigor.
- Based on the feedback, authors may be asked to revise and resubmit.
- Final selection is at the sole discretion of the Editorial Board.
- Minor editorial changes (grammar, formatting, title styling, etc.) may be made by the board.
