MAIMS 5th National Moot Court Competition, 2024, aims to provide a platform for students across India to showcase their advocacy and research skills by competing in a professional and challenging environment. The purpose of organizing this competition is to help the participants nurture their prime advocacy skills. The Department of Law, MAIMS has been successful in organizing several mega-events in the recent past, including Intra Moot Court Competition (2019), Intra Trial Advocacy Competition (2020), 1st National Moot Court Competition (2021), 3rd National Moot Court Competition (2022), 4th National Moot Court Competition (2023) as well as various Induction Moot Court Competitions.

The Inaugural Ceremony of MAIMS 5th National Moot Court Competition, 2024 will be organized on 8th November, 2024 in online mode followed by the Preliminary Rounds on 9th November, 2024. The qualifying teams shall be competing for offline oral rounds in the premises of Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies, Rohini, Delhi on 25th & 26th November, 2024 followed by the celebration of India's 75th Constitution Day, 2024.





OBJECTIVES



- Engage deeply with current and relevant legal issues to foster critical thinking.
- Develop advanced skills in advocacy, legal research, and proficient legal writing.
- Cultivate teamwork abilities by collaborating effectively.
- Showcase a strong commitment to advocacy and future legal practice through active participation.
- Enhance problem-solving abilities by tackling complex legal scenarios and case studies.
- Gain practical experience and insights into the legal profession through hands-on activities and simulations.

COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- All the students who are duly enrolled and pursuing a full time three-year [LL.B.] programme or five-year (integrated) [LL.B. (Hons.)] programme from any institution/university recognized by the Bar Council of India or any other equivalent competent authority shall be eligible to participate in the Competition.
- Only one team is permitted to participate from each participating Institution.
- Each team shall consist of three members. This number cannot be modified under any circumstance.
- In a team consisting of three members, two members shall be designated as 'Speakers', and the third member shall be designated as 'Researcher'.
- All the participating teams must confirm participation by filling out a Registration Form on or before 11:59 PM IST, 7th October 2024.
- As per the rules, each team upon completion of registration shall be allotted a unique Team Code for the competition. Each team must use the Team Code for further communication with the organizing committee during the course of the competition.
- Any change must be intimated to the organizing committee at the earliest through e-mail at mootcourtsociety@maims.ac.in. Such change must be accompanied by a freshly filled registration form.
- Post registration, participants will receive an email, signifying the acceptance of their request for participation latest by 9th October 2024.
- The participating teams are required to pay Rs. 3,000/- for Phase-I registration for the preliminary rounds and Rs. 3,000/- for the Phase-II for the advanced rounds as the registration fees.

STRUCTURE OF THE COMPETITION

The Competition shall consist of four rounds:

- 1. Preliminary Rounds- I & II
- 2. Quarter Final Round
- 3. Semi-Final Round
- 4. Final Round



PRELIMINARY ROUNDS:

The Preliminary Rounds will be held on 9th November, 2024 in Online Mode. All the teams will be competing twice in the Preliminary Rounds. After competing, the best 8 teams will advance to the Quarter-Final Round.



QUARTER FINAL ROUND:

The best eight teams will qualify for the Quarter-Final Round, which will be held on 25th November, 2024 in Offline Mode. After competing, the top 4 teams will advance to the Semi-Final Round.

SEMI-FINAL ROUND:

The best four teams will qualify for the Semi-Final Round, which will be held on <u>25th November</u>, <u>2024 in Offline Mode</u>. After competing, the top 2 teams will advance to the Final Round.



FINAL ROUND:

The Final Round shall be held on 26th November, 2024 in Offline Mode. The best two teams from the Semi-Final Round will qualify for the Finals. After competing, the team with the highest score will be announced as the Winner of the Competition.
