# **National Moot Court Competition 2025**

The present moot problem revolves around the legal and regulatory challenges posed by the establishment of a large-scale data processing facility by Tech Horizon Rad Solutions Ltd. (THRSL) in the ecologically sensitive region of Kriti, within the State of Garu. The case highlights key concerns related to environmental sustainability, data privacy, and corporate accountability. The NGO AKS has raised allegations regarding excessive water consumption, pollution, and carbon emissions, leading to legal proceedings before the Green Tribunal. Additionally, serious data privacy violations—including unauthorized collection, inadequate security measures, and cross-border data transfers—have resulted in a criminal investigation under the Garu Nyaya Sanhita, with the CEO of THRSL facing charges and denied bail. The case has also sparked international tensions, with the neighbouring State of Nakul and other foreign governments threatening trade sanctions over data privacy breaches and environmental harm. Given the far-reaching implications, AKS has sought the Supreme Court's intervention for expeditious adjudication. The moot problem raises critical legal questions concerning environmental law, data protection, transboundary harm, corporate liability, and the grant of bail in cases of severe regulatory violations.

# **Brief Rules**

- The teams are required to submit a soft copy of the Registration Form, Travel Form and Proof of Payment of participation fee (ensure that the proof of payment has the following components visible- Name of Payer, Ref. number of payment, Date, last 4 digits of the Account No.) of Rs. 2500/- via email to mootcourt@ncuindia.edu before 11:59 PM 20th March, 2025.
- The students requiring accommodation have to pay Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two thousand) per team per day (including all food and travel i.e. from the Accommodation to the University and vice-versa only on the dates of competition). The said amount shall be paid directly to the hotel via scanning QR Code provided by the Moot Court Committee by 3rd April 2025.
- Each team shall be allotted a Team Code along with the confirmation email on 15th March, 2025. The Draw of Lots for the Preliminary rounds will take place on 4th April 2025 before the inaugural function.
- All participating teams must submit soft copy of their memorial in PDF format, for both sides by 25th March, 2025 by e-mail addressed to mootcourt@ncuindia.edu or alternatively submit via https://forms.gle/Sx5TDU2HqvyhD5ny5 memorial after this date shall be accepted in any case. No extension will be entertained in any circumstance.
- All participating teams shall bring with them 05 sets of Memorials each side, (total 10 Memorials) and submit them during the registration upon arrival on the date of competition.
