The International Press (IP) is a vital committee of the Model United Nations (MUN), responsible for documenting, analyzing, and presenting the proceedings of the conference. The IP team fosters creativity, critical thinking, and journalistic skills while maintaining professional ethics and neutrality. Whether through articles, photographs, or satirical cartoons, the International Press adds depth and colour to the MUN experience, making it more impactful and memorable. The IP (journalist only) will :-

- Focus on reporting and questioning delegates during the MUN
- Journalists will be selected based on their writing skills and prior experience.
- During the conference, they will observe debates, take detailed notes, and write concise reports summarizing key discussions and developments.
- Journalists will also engage with delegates during caucuses, asking insightful and relevant questions to gain deeper perspectives.
- Reports must be submitted on time and revised based on feedback.
- Evaluation will be based on accuracy, quality, and depth of analysis.
