SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Abstract Submission - Authors are invited to submit an abstract not exceeding 500 words. The abstract should be clear and concise, providing a brief introduction to the topic, the intended research focus, and the expected conclusion. Abstracts can be submitted via this [link](#).

- Title of the Paper to be at the top.
- Name of the Authors to be written under the title in the following format: Name, Designation, Affiliated organisation; Co-author Name, Co-author Designation, Co-author Affiliated Organisation (if any)
- *Font*: Times New Roman, 12 for body, 14 for headings, and 10 for footnotes.
- *Margins*: Top, Bottom, Left and Right - 2.5 cm.
- *Spacing*: Line spacing of 1.5 for text and 1.0 for footnotes.
- *Alignment and Layout*: Justified text, A4 size.
- *Citation Style*: Bluebook 20th edition.
- *Plagiarism Policy*: Papers with plagiarism exceeding 10% shall not be considered.
- Use of generative AI is prohibited.
- Co-authorship of upto 2 (two) authors is permissible. Separate registration fee to be paid by both.
- Abstracts to contain keywords at the end in the following format: Keywords: xvn, zcb.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Complete Paper Submission - Once the abstract is accepted, authors must submit their complete papers adhering to the following guidelines:

- *Font:* Times New Roman, 12 for body, 14 for headings, 12 for sub-headings, and 10 for footnotes.
- *Margins:* Top, Bottom, Left and Right - 2.5 cm.
- *Spacing:* Line spacing of 1.5 for body and 1.0 for footnotes.
- *Word Limit:* No minimum word limit. Maximum 15,000 words (including footnotes).
- *Page Numbers:* Bottom center.
- *Alignment and Layout:* Justified text, A4 size.
- *Citation Style:* Bluebook 20th edition.
- *Originality:* Submitted papers must be original, unpublished, and not under consideration elsewhere.
- *Plagiarism Policy:* Papers with plagiarism exceeding 10% will be automatically disqualified. Use of AI is prohibited.
- Co-authorship of upto 2 (two) authors is permissible.

Complete papers are expected to be submitted for holistic evaluation and feedback.

However, this provision is only available for the international participants and selected Indian participants to be availed only depending on circumstances communicated to the committee. Please note that this slot will be limited and the registration fee will remain the same.
